World Youth Day 2027: Young adults ages 18–35 are invited to join the Archdiocese of St. Boniface and the Archdiocese of Winnipeg delegation to World Youth Day 2027 in Seoul, South Korea, from July 27th –August 11th,

2027. Founded by St. John Paul II, World Youth Day gathers young people from around the world to encounter Christ in a profound and personal way and to experience the universal

Church with young people from every nation. The 2027 theme, *“Take courage! I have overcome the world”* (John 16:33), calls young adults to live with hope and bold faith rooted in the Resurrection. This pilgrimage offers prayer, catechesis, the sacraments, the joy of the global Church, lasting friendships, and a chance to grow spiritually, culturally and personally. The cost is \$2,500 (excluding flights).

Lord: Please join us on February 2nd at 6:30 p.m. for a special Mass celebrating the Presentation of the Lord, when Jesus was presented in the temple and recognized as the Light of the World. Parishioners are invited to bring candles to be blessed during the liturgy.

The Year of St. Francis: Pope Leo XIV has proclaimed a special Year of St. Francis to mark the 800th anniversary of the saint's death. This time of grace continues until January 2027 and invites the faithful to deepen their spiritual lives by following the example of St. Francis of Assisi. During this period, a plenary indulgence may be obtained under the usual conditions of sacramental confession, reception of Holy Communion, and prayer for the intentions of the Pope. This grace is available to those who make a

pilgrimage to a Franciscan conventual church or to a place of worship dedicated to St. Francis. The elderly, the sick and the homebound may also share in this grace by uniting themselves spiritually through prayer and offering their sufferings to God. In a world marked by division and unrest, this special year calls us to rediscover peace with God, with one another and with creation. St. Francis, pray for us!

Pray with the Pope: This global prayer initiative, which launched on January 7th, invites Catholics to unite in prayer with the Pope's monthly intentions. Through brief video and audio messages, it encourages prayer rooted in Scripture and lived in daily life, strengthening communion with the universal Church. January's intention invites us to pray with the Word of God, asking that Scripture guide, inspire and renew our faith. All are invited to pray individually, as a family, or as a community, joining the Church worldwide in prayer for the needs of our world.
